Field Engineer provides inspection and testing services on well locations. The position follows standard work methods and practices safe work habits to ensure production and/or services are as efficient and safe as possible.

Major Duties:

- Performs and supervises rig floor electromagnetic inspection as tubing is pulled from the well during workovers
- Detects flaws with tubing using EMI technology and visual inspection
- Directs and moves tubing into place for inspection. Follows safe procedures for laydown and/or movement of tubing
- Compiles post job reports, testing, and any additional backup data
- Drives equipment to and from location. Rigs up/down inspection equipment
- Maintains a clean job site: picks up all tools and equipment and secures job site each day to eliminate potential hazards
- Complies with applicable specifications and standards
- Ensures safety policies and incident reporting procedures are followed
- Cleans truck and tools, restocks supplies, etc.
- Performs required maintenance and provides reports

Qualifications and Skills Required:

- Must have basic mechanical and oil industry knowledge
- Safeland or PEC certification preferred
- Outlook, Microsoft, Excel knowledge as well as basic computer skills
- College degree preferred but will consider high school diploma or GED
- Effective communication skills
- Must be able to read and write in English
- Ability to interact with others and communicate effectively, reading and understanding safety regulations
- Must pass pre-employment drug and alcohol screening as well as background check
- Driver's license with clean driving record as commuting to and from job sites is essential
