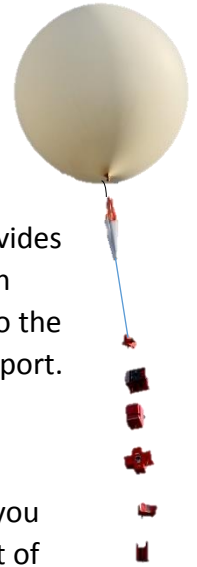


Watch the Near-Space Balloon Competition (NSBC) live!



The Near-Space Balloon Competition is a state-wide, NASA-sponsored program that provides middle and high school students the chance to engage in a real-world engineering design process. They propose an experiment, design and construct a payload that is launched to the edge of space on 2000-gram high altitude balloons, recover data, and produce a final report. These hardworking students are able to study multidisciplinary subject matter through creativity, collaboration, and fun!
