Calling all STEM Ambassadors!

Position Details:

- The appointment begins *August 16, 2018* and students are paid \$12/hour.
- Students will participate in public outreach events, hands-on projects, and K-12 educational activities.

- Students work flexible hours, generally ~40 hours per semester.
- Students must be self-motivated and capable of organizing their own events.

STEM Ambassadors are required to participate in a **training session** at UND in the fall semester of 2018 where they will gain experience conducting various STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) and NASA lesson plans. Students should feel comfortable visiting K-12 schools on their own and leading these activities. STEM Ambassadors work individually, with other STEM Ambassadors, and with the NDSGC team, for different outreach events. *Education students are highly encouraged to apply.*

Eligibility:

- U.S. Citizen
- Enrolled at an NDSGC [affiliate college or university](#)
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Pursuing a degree in Education or a STEM field
